
Postcard Competition April 28

Art Show

- Currently there are 19 members who have signed up for our 20th Annual Art Show.
- **Please note:** the date for the last chance to sign up for this event has changed from the previous time line to May 26 General Meeting. Participants must pay entry fee (\$50) and schedule a hosting date at time of registration.
- A donation of a Door Prize is needed. Art must be in final gift form. Interested exhibitors are asked to contact Annual Art Show Chair Barb Overholt.

Guild Birthday Potluck

The Guild reserves the right to disqualify a painting if there is reasonable doubt about copyright infringement or plagiarism.

- Work entered for a show must be the artist's original work in concept and execution.
- Work cannot be copied from copyrighted material or photographs belonging to another person or organization except with the copyright holder's explicit written permission.
- Work cannot be the reproduction of a painting done by another person even if the original artist is acknowledged on the painting.
- Work cannot be the reproduction of a historic painting.
