Executive Board Meeting Minutes

May 9

The meeting was called to order by Co-President Denis Wik at 12:50 p.m. In attendance were: Annual Art Show Chair Barb Overholt, Vice-President Marlene Bird, Treasurer Sharon La Bouff, Secretary Susanne Koga, Programs Co-Chair Mary Kahn.

Annual Art Show:

- The Board discussed revising the check-in procedure for our art show. It was decided that chairs would be set around the perimeter of the room. Upon entering, exhibitors will see President Wik who will provide them with a numbered slip. Exhibitors are to unpack their art and place along the gallery walls, and seat themselves until their number is called. Susanne and Marlene will manage the Sign-in Table, and Mary and Barb will inspect the matting and framing of art. Improperly framed pieces will not be allowed in the show. The exhibitors represent both the Guild and the Triton Museum of Art and wish to maintain high standards. Barb will write up a detailed explanation of the new check-in procedure and distribute at the May 25 and June 22 General meetings as well as via email.
- At this writing, there are four exhibitors who will have proxies: Elvira Rascov, Dave and Liyuza Eisbach, Sharon La Bouff.
- Postcards will be distributed at our June 22 General Meeting for the best impact.
- The deadline for art registration and hosting has changed from June to May. The last day to sign up for reception food contributions is at the June 22 General Meeting.
- As of this writing, there are 27 artists participating and if each artist submits three pieces, there will be 81 paintings. This number will work well in the gallery space available. People with larger paintings (i.e., beyond a framed 18x24) will submit fewer.
- Barb obtained biographies from new members participating in the show and they have been added to the Guild's Biography Binder which will be available for visitors to read.

Gallery ID Tags: Exhibitors may submit up to **three pieces of art**. Any art larger than a framed 18" x 24", please contact the Art Show Chair. Barb will need the exhibitors' art information regarding each painting

ASAP to prepare the Gallery ID Tags. Exhibitors must send this information to her **before** Monday, June 10.

Plein Air at Triton • July 27: There will be a large family event taking over the grounds of the Triton this day. Depending on how many Guild members participate in plein air, this should not be a problem. Beautiful grounds across the street at City Hall are a perfect alternative venue for plein air.

National Night Out at Triton: Barb is in communication with Triton on their involvement in this event this year. Last year, the Guild was able to open the gallery to the public on National Night Out with the Guild's Board members in attendance.

Future April General Meetings: After some discussion, the Board decided that the Members Potluck portion be eliminated at future April meetings to allow for a demo artist. The Guild would continue to celebrate its anniversary with cake in addition to the regular refreshments. The Hospitality Roster will reflect this change and the Annual Art Show Postcard Competition will once again be held in April of 2020.

Contributions to Venue Rental: The Guild is not always receiving the \$2 member contributions at monthly meetings. The Board considered including this \$2 as part of the Guild's annual dues. This idea will be brought to members for a vote at a future meeting.

2020 Demo Artists: The board felt it would be of interest to members to learn more about the materials and techniques used by some of our Guild artists who create abstract paintings. Barb will inquire with Elton Glover and Diann Klink of their interest in presenting their techniques to Guild members.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:20 p.m.

ART SHOW

New Procedure for Art Drop-off

A new procedure will be in place for dropping off your artwork at the Community Gallery. Instructions on this new procedure will be provided to exhibitors via handouts at the May 25 and June 22 General Meetings and via email.

Framing standards for our meetings are relaxed than our Annual Art Show. Therefore, how your art is framed will be of core importance in this year's check-in procedure and for future art shows.

1. Please familiarize yourself by reading the "Annual Art Show" information on Pages 8-9 and "Guild Framing Requirements" on Page 11 of your copy of the Guild's "Constitution and Bylaws" booklet.
2. All art must be the original art (no prints with the exception of Photography).
3. The art exhibited in this show should represent your best creations. If your art does not meet the professional matting and framing standards requested, it will be rejected.
4. Please arrive at the designated time and your framing will be reviewed by the Executive Board. Please be patient in this new procedure.
5. Once your matting and framing has been accepted, you'll be directed to the Sign-in Table where you will sign your Liability Waiver, verify your artwork listing, and receive your Gallery ID Tags.

If you need help in understanding the framing requirements, please contact any Executive Board member.
