Triton's Midsummer Multicultural Art Celebration:

Barb Overholt discussed the flyer from Jeff Bramschreiber and sent a copy via email on April 6 to Guild membership. This event is scheduled for June 29, 2019 and is open to Guild members who wish to participate. President Denis Wik will revisit this topic at our upcoming April 27 General Meeting.

Annual Art Show:

At the April 27 General Meeting, the Art Show Chair will announce the need for a door prize. Exhibitors who wish to donate a piece of art for this event should keep in mind that their donated work must be of good quality, current in its creation (within the last five years) and framed according to "art show standards."

– Food Sign-ups:

The Opening Reception food sign-up sheet will be available to exhibitors at the April 27 General Meeting. If an exhibitor is unable to attend the Opening Reception, a donated fee of \$40 will be required. Please bring the food that you have signed up for – do not substitute with another food item. Bring enough food for at least 20 people.

- New Member Biographies:

In an effort to keep our membership biography book current, the Art Show Chair has requested (via email) that members who are new to the Guild and exhibiting this year, submit biographies to her by May 6. If exhibitors would like to include a photo of themselves and their art, please send separate JPEG images of these items.

- Art Show Check-In Procedure:

The framing standards for our general meetings are much more relaxed than the Annual Art Show. Therefore, how your work is framed will be a core part of the check-in procedure for this year's show. The Art Show Chair will discuss these procedural guidelines at the May 25 General Meeting so please have the expectation that these guidelines will be adhered to for this year's show and for future shows.

- Gallery ID Information:

Art Show participants will need to submit their gallery identification information to the Art Show Chair by **Monday, June 10**. Look for upcoming communications in the Guild's monthly newsletter and via email from the Art Show Chair.

• Potluck Celebration Party:

Don't forget to bring your personal plate, eating utensils and a savory dish to the April 27th General Meeting as we will be celebrating the Guild's 54th Anniversary. Remember to bring your own glass if you do not wish to drink coffee or tea. We are trying to minimize our plastic and paper materials and in so doing, reduce our carbon footprint.
